THE COST OF ATTENDING MULTNOMAH SEMINARY IS APPROXIMATELY \$26,200 PER YEAR. THIS INCLUDES TUITION, FEES, BOARD, ROOM, \$1300 FOR HEALTH INSURANCE, AND APPROXIMATELY \$4500 FOR BOOKS, SUPPLIES AND MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS. MARRIED STUDENTS ADD \$3200 FOR SPOUSE AND \$1000 FOR EACH DEPENDENT. YOU WILL NEED TO GUARANTEE THAT YOU HAVE THIS AMOUNT OF MONEY IN ADDITION TO YOUR TRAVELING EXPENSES, OR THAT YOU HAVE A SPONSOR WHO WILL GUARANTEE TO PAY YOUR EXPENSES. A SPONSOR IS REQUIRED TO COMPLETE AN AFFIDAVIT OF SUPPORT, IMMIGRATION FORM I-134.

FOREIGN EXCHANGE

MULTNOMAH RECOGNIZES THAT FOREIGN STUDENTS COMING TO THE UNITED STATES OFTEN FACE FINANCIAL HARDSHIPS. IN RECOGNITION OF THAT HARDSHIP, MULTNOMAH WILL OFFER A TUITION DISCOUNT OF 15%. THIS POLICY IS SUBJECT TO REVIEW AND CHANGE EACH ACADEMIC YEAR.
