Multnomah Bible College and Multnomah Biblical Seminary are schools of Multnomah University, featuring a four-year coeducational, interdenominational Bible college and graduate-level seminary located in Portland, Oregon. Founded in 1936, the college and seminary have established a renowned heritage of excellence in biblical education equipping Christian men and women to transform our culture and the world. The college offers B.A. degrees as well as three university M.A. programs. The seminary offers the M.A., M.Div., and Th.M. degrees. Multnomah University is accredited with the Association for Biblical Higher Education (ABHE), and the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU). Multnomah Biblical Seminary is accredited with the Association of Theological Schools (ATS). In addition, Multnomah University is an affiliate with the Council for Christian Colleges and Universities (CCCU).

The university employs approximately 50 full-time faculty as well as several part-time and adjunct faculty members. Spring 2011 enrollment is 915 students.
