When will my payment and deposit be due?

Your \$100 enrollment deposit is due prior to registering, along with your housing application, and housing deposit if applicable. Payment is due January 14th.

When do I register?

After you have paid your enrollment deposit, you will receive an email giving you access to the online registration system (November 20 – January 3). Instructions for registration will be included in that email. If you are not registered before orientation, there will be a late registration opportunity on January 10th.

Where do I purchase books and supplies?
