# **HOUSING APPLICATION DEADLINES**

## Residence Halls Returning Students

- Fall 2013 deadline: May 1, 2013
- Applications received thereafter are subject to a \$100 late application fee.

# Apartment-Style Housing Returning Students

- Fall 2013 deadline: April 5, 2013
- Applications received thereafter are subject to a \$100 late application fee.

# **All Housing Applicants**

#### **New Students**

For priority housing, apply by:

- May 1, 2013 for Fall 2013
- December 1, 2013 for Spring 2014
- \*Note: All housing assignments are subject to change if MU deems it necessary.

# **HOUSING REQUIREMENT AND ELIGIBILITY**

#### **Residence Halls**

- Students must be enrolled in at least 9 credits and be under the age of 30 to live in the Residence Halls.
- Note: Students that are single, under 21 as of the first day of the semester, and taking at least 10 credits are required to live in Residence Hall housing.

#### **Apartment-Style Housing**

• Students must be single, 21 or older, and enrolled at least three-quarter time in his/her program to qualify for apartment-style housing. (Definition of three-quarter time: 9 credits for undergraduates, 6 credits for graduate students)

#### **Residence Halls**

Move-In Dates:

- Fall: Thursday, August 22, 2013
- Spring: Thursday, January 9, 2014

## Move-Out Date:

- Saturday, May 10, 2014 by 4:00 p.m.
- \* The Residence Halls are closed December 13, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. through Thursday, January 9, 2014 at 1:00 p.m.

# **MEAL PLANS**

# **AGREEMENT TERMS**

#### **Traditional Student Term**

For students residing on campus for Fall semester, this housing Agreement is for the full academic year covering both fall and spring semesters.

- For students beginning MU in the fall 2013 semester, the Agreement term dates are as follows:
  - o Apartment Housing: August 21, 2013 May 10, 2014
  - o Residence Hall Housing: August 22 December 13, 2013 and January 9 May 10, 2014
- For new students beginning MU in the spring 2014 semester, the Agreement term dates are as follows:
  - o Apartment Housing: January 8, 2014 May 10, 2014
  - Residence Hall Housing: January 9, 2014 May 10, 2014

#### **MAC and DCP Student Term**

For students enrolled in the MAC and DCP programs, the term of this housing agreement may be tailored to match the student's corresponding academic terms. If this is done, the student will be notified in advance and an addendum indicating the alternative term dates will be drawn up, signed by the student, and stored on file with MU Student Services.

- 1. The Residence Hall deposit is applied to the student's housing bill after move-in. This deposit is non-refundable.
- 2. The Ambassador Apartment deposit is a refundable security deposit. Once a student is graduating (or not returning to housing for the subsequent semester for any other reason), the deposit will be refunded within 30 days of move-out less any damages, cleaning fees, lost key charges, or any other remaining MU balances.
- 3. If you need to withdraw your housing application prior to the Agreement term, please notify us as soon as possible. \$100 will be withheld from your deposit. A student is liable to fulfill the entirety of the contract if he/she has not withdrawn prior to the Agreement start dates shown above.
- 4. Late application fee applies only to returning students who submit their applications after their deadline (see page 3 of this document).
- 5. If a student is withdrawing from MU before the end of the Agreement term, he/she must move out of campus housing (the specific move-out date will be arranged with Housing Staff). The student is responsible to pay the room cost for the remainder of the current semester (or term) plus a \$200 Agreement Termination fee.
  - a. Finishing Fall Semester, but not returning to MU for Spring: If the student gives advance notice and vacates in the proper manner by 5pm on December 13, 2013, only the \$200 fee will apply (no additional room costs will be charged).
  - b. In all cases, the student is still responsible for room damages, cleaning, improper check-out, or lost key charges in addition to the \$200 Agreement Termination fee.

#### Notes

- A resident who moves out during the term of his/her Agreement must schedule a meeting with the Dean of Student Services or his/her designee. The student will be provided with the appropriate move-out form (depending on the circumstances). This form must be filled out in its entirety and turned in to the Student Services office.
- Some fees may be waived by the Dean of Student Services or his/her designee due to extenuating circumstances (i.e. academic dismissal, serious personal or family illness or death, etc.).
