Communication - 8 credits: College Writing (6); Speech (2)

Science & Math - 9 credits: College-level Math (3); Lab Science (3); additional Math or Science (3)

Social Science - 9 credits: non-History Social Science (6); **US History I** (3)

Diversity Elective - 3 credits

Physical Education - 2 credits

Electives - 17 credits

**Students who enter Multnomah with transfer credit may choose to take advantage of reduced Bible core requirements for transfer students as follows:**

*Sophomores (31-60 credits): Complete 21 hours of the core. Take 4 of 5 Bible courses and all three Theology courses.*

*Juniors (61-92 credits): Complete 16 hours of the core. Take 4 of 5 Bible courses and TH 310.*
