If all General Education requirements listed below are met prior to enrolling at Multnomah, a student may be able to complete their program in two years by following the course layout above.

Communication - 8 credits: College Writing (6); Speech (2)

Humanities - 12 credits: Fine Arts (2); Literature (3); Humanities electives (7)

Science & Math - 9 credits: Statistics (3); Lab Science (3); additional math or science (3)

Social Science - 9 credits: US History or Western Civ (3); General Psychology (3); non-psychology Social Science (3)

Diversity Elective - 3 credits

Physical Education - 2 credits

Electives - 15 credits

Students who enter Multnomah with transfer credit may choose to take advantage of reduced Bible core requirements for transfer students as follows:

Sophomores (31-60 credits): Complete 21 hours of the core. Take 4 of 5 Bible courses and all three Theology courses.

Juniors (61-92 credits): Complete 16 hours of the core. Take 4 of 5 Bible courses and TH 310.
