

Nuna Brand Scholarship

Priority Deadline: June 1, 2019 – Deadline: August 1, 2019

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION:

Multnomah University is a diverse community that seeks to equip students to love Christ and serve their neighbors through their lives and work.

To this end, Multnomah University and Nuna Baby Essentials, Inc have partnered to create the Nuna Brand Scholarship. The scholarship will be awarded to two (2) undergraduate students and covers full tuition and room and board for the traditional Fall/Spring academic year.

CRITERIA:

- Incoming or returning full-time Portland Campus students admitted to any Multnomah University Undergraduate program.
- A completed FAFSA with Multnomah's school code (003206 www.fafsa.gov)
- Must be employed (or have a pending offer letter, if prior to enrollment) by Nuna Baby Essentials, Inc.
- A letter of recommendation for this scholarship from a Multnomah faculty member
- Must have demonstrated financial need (as determined by the FAFSA)
- Students must be in compliance with Multnomah's standards for student conduct

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- 1) Complete the FAFSA for the 2019-2020 award year (include Multnomah's school code: 003206)
- 2) Submit proof of employment (or a pending offer letter if prior to enrollment) with Nuna Baby Essentials, Inc.
- 3) Submit letter of recommendation from a Multnomah faculty member
- 4) Submit a 1-2-page essay response to the following questions (include your full name, student ID, and contact information at the top of the essay):

How will your educational experience at Multnomah University contribute to your immediate or long-term career goals? From a financial standpoint, what impact would this scholarship have on your education?

- 5) Send all required documents to finaid@multnomah.edu by August 1st

REVIEW PROCESS:

Only complete applications will be considered. You, as the applicant, are responsible for confirming all documents have been received by the August 1 deadline. Staff in the Financial Aid Office will confirm each application is complete including a Multnomah University admissions application and a FAFSA with MU's school code. The Director of Financial Aid will convene a scholarship committee consisting of representatives from MU administration and faculty. Finalists for the award will submit to an interview with members of the scholarship committee. Recipients will be notified by October 1.

Per federal regulations, a student may not receive financial aid that exceeds the institutions cost of attendance; a revision to your financial aid package may occur.

Recipients may receive the scholarship in multiple years but it is not automatically renewed.
